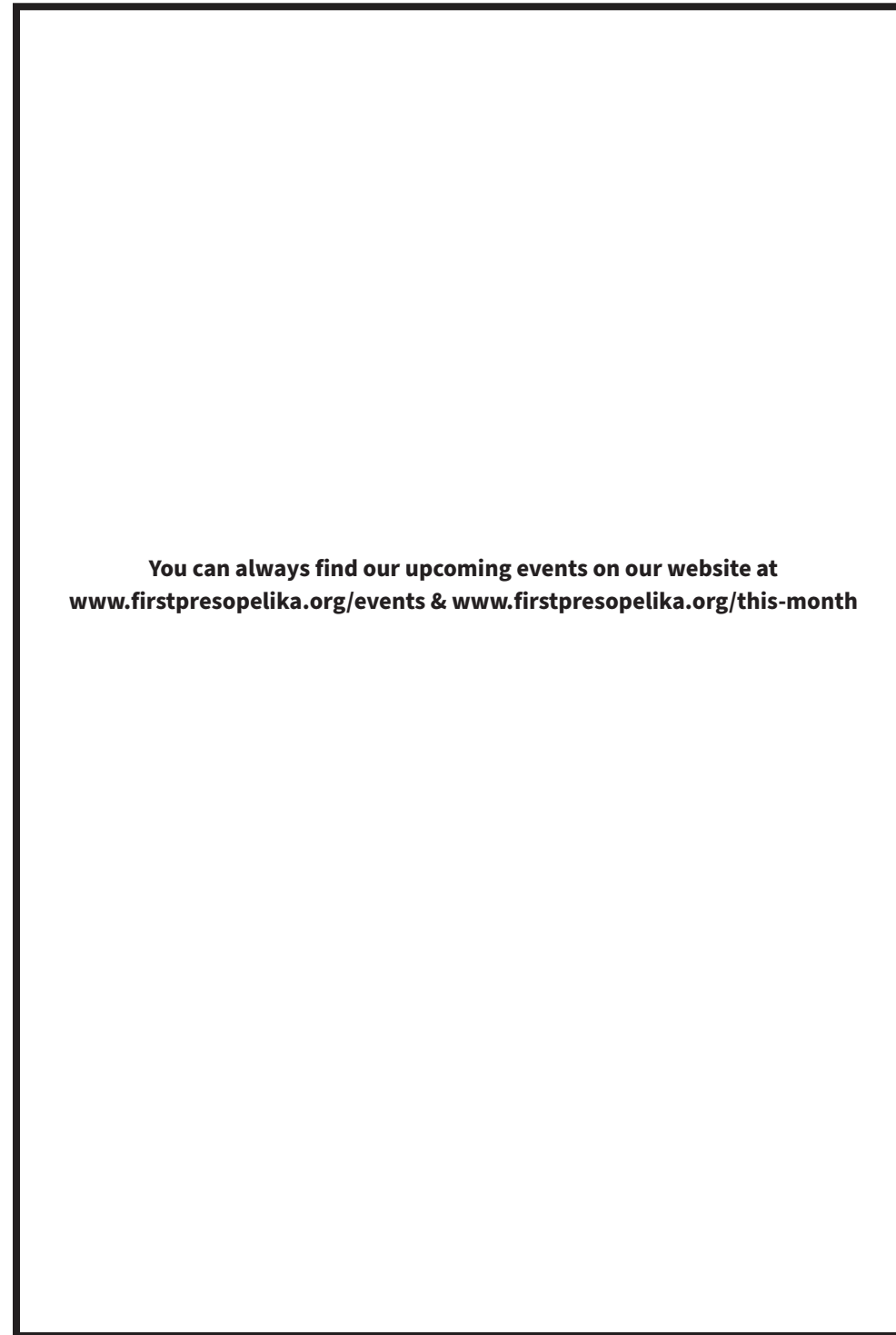
FPO MISSIONS MOMENT

Our Missionaries

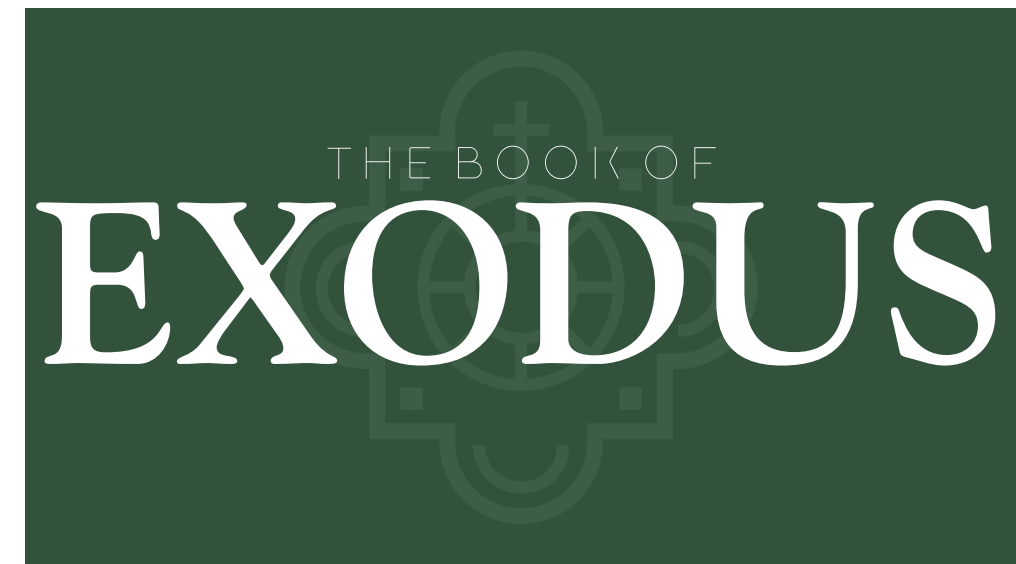
